APPLICATION PROCESS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- There is no fee to be part of the festival. You will be provided with a trestle table and two chairs.
- All manufactures must provide staff on the day to showcase and sell their products (no one can sell your products like you can!)
- There is limited refrigeration space, so please bring cooler boxes to store foods for the duration of the event.
- All products must be clearly labelled and indicate if they are halal etc.
- All stall holders must be registered with STREATRADER and supply a copy of Statement of Trade with the application. Contact Jackie.Turner@whittlesea.vic.gov.au at City of Whittlesea for more information.
- Please include a copy of your Insurance (Public Liability Insurance) with your application.
- Site access is from 8.45am. All Festival stallholders must be in attendance from 10am -2pm.
- All electrical items must be tagged.
- If you wish to bring promotional banners please place them to the side of your table. Promotional materials can be displayed on your allocated table
- Please supply a high resolution copy of your logo.
